## Reporting cyber-bullying

Should I report to the school? If the bullying involves other children from their school, children's home, or youth centre, report the incident there first. Staff should have an anti-bullying policy, should follow these procedures and keep you informed.

They may get specialist support from other agencies like the police or the local authority.

Who else can I report to? You can report cyber-bullying and other cyber-safety concerns to

- CEOP (Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre)
- The company providing your internet or phone service
- The site or forum where the bullying is happening

If a child is in immediate danger of harm, or a crime is being committed, phone the police straight away on 999. In a non-emergency you can call the police on 101
